

General Meeting Minutes

Bill Lowrey, President, called the meeting to order at 9:15 A.M. Nancy Bickers led an opening prayer. Bill led the Pledge of Allegiance and the Texas Pledge.

The minutes were read by Martha Callaway. There were no corrections or additions. The report will be filed as read.

Treasurer Delilah Parsley gave the Quarterly Treasurer's Report. There were no additions or corrections and the treasurer's report will be filed as read.

**New Business:**

Bill Lowrey reported that in executive session the budget request for the October 2011 Texas W rally as presented by Gary Rigsby was approved. The rate will be \$90 for a one-person rig and \$120 for a two-person rig, and a late fee after Oct. 1 of \$10.00. Registration forms will be on the TexasW website after May 1, 2011.

Gary Rigsby, 1st Vice-president in charge of Meeting and Rally Coordination, reported on the Texas W State rally on October 21-23, 2011, at The Campsite in Sanger, Tx.

Gary reported that Texas W officers will host the October 2011 Rally, but that all chapters will have shared responsibilities. The theme will be military, and veterans could wear their uniforms or bring any memorabilia concerning their military service. The service project will be Wounded Warriors. All proceeds from a military money tree, a silent auction, baskets, and contributions will go to the Wounded Warriors organization. Brochures describing activities and brochures describing pre-rally activities were given to all members.

Bonnie Tittle, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice-president in charge of Membership, reported that efforts will continue to recruit new members on the WIT list of new owners. She also stressed the importance of drawing non-Texas W members back into the Texas W club.

Bill Lowrey reported on a letter received from Doug Formanek, WIT General Manager, who stated that the WIT guidelines had been changed allowing presidents of local and state chapters to serve for five years, lay off for two years, and then begin another presidency,

The president reported that in Executive Session approval was given to give Mike Todd, Webmaster for TexasW, the small sum of \$15 every quarter to cover his expenses,

With no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 10:05 A.M.
